



Contract Form

THE CONTRACT

By this contract between *ROBERT BROWN VIDEO* (hereinafter called the Videographers) and the Clients it is mutually agreed that the Videographers shall provide services and/or goods as specified in the schedule overleaf and that the Clients shall pay the Videographers the amount due for the said goods and/or services.

It is mutually agreed that the following terms of the agreement form an integral part of this contract and that no variation or modification of this contract shall be effective unless accepted by the Videographers in writing.

1. BOOKING FEE - A booking fee of £30.00 is charged for Video when the client signs this contract. This fee is deducted in full from the final invoice.

2. PAYMENTS - Payment for the minimum order (Specified in the schedule) and any other known fee shall be payable one week before the wedding date. Payment for additional copies shall be payable also on this date. NB. The Videographer is contracted for a **maximum** of 8 Hours. Anything over this will be charged at £25.00 per hour or part thereof.

3. VIDEO - The Videographers will provide a pleasing colour balance but cannot guarantee exact colour matching. Owing to anomalous reflections caused by a combination of certain dyes and materials, especially man-made fibres, it is sometimes impossible to record on tape the exact colour of materials as seen by the human eye.

4. RE-ORDERS(COPIES) - all re-orders(copies) shall be treated as an extension of this contract.

5. COPYRIGHT - By the signing of this contract the Clients assigns to the Videographers the copyright of all video specified in the schedule. The Videographers may display samples of this order.

6. LICENCE - The Videographers shall be granted artistic licence in relation to the poses filmed and the location used. The Videographers judgements regarding the locations and poses shall be deemed correct.

7. PRICES - All services and/or goods are supplied at the prices ruling at the time of supply.

8. FORCE MAJEURE - The due performance of this contract is subject to alteration or cancellation by the Videographers owing to any cause beyond their control. In the unlikely event of total Videographic failure or cancellation of this contract by the Videographers, liability shall be limited to a full refund of all monies paid.

9. CANCELLATION - The Clients may repudiate this contract at any time by giving written notice to the Videographers. Should notice of cancellation be received by the Videographers less than six weeks prior to the appointment, the Clients should pay the Videographers a sum equal to 45% of the then current price of the minimum order specified in the schedule. The said sum shall be payable as compensation it being an agreed estimate of the loss the Videographers would suffer.

10. COMPLAINTS - In the unlikely event of an unresolved complaint the Clients may request the Edinburgh Association of Videographers to act as independent arbitrators.

I have read and fully understand the schedule and terms of agreement on this contract and realise that this contract becomes effective immediately.
